### Objectives of Year 7 Catch Up Funding

- To close the gap by providing intensive literacy and numeracy support and raise the attainment of those students entitled to Catch up Premium
- To raise self-esteem and aspirations of students entitled to Catch up Premium
- To enhance existing provision.
- To identify concerns and target intervention and support to accelerate progress
- To intervene quickly if any chosen strategy or intervention fails to show impact
- To ensure that parents are informed and involved where appropriate.

### Summary of Activities for which catch up funding will be used in 2018-19

#### **Literacy:**

- Additional Specialist Literacy provision - through the support department
- Additional Adult Support - for those most in need in English and Maths classes (LSA)
- Homework Clubs – in the library and in the SEN department
- Pastoral Support – via the Academy's pastoral system and through the Pastoral Leader. Regular monitoring of student's progress.
- 1 – 1 Reading Intervention
- Literacy Resources – Comprehension, reading and writing materials
- Creation of an extra En/Mathematics class in Year 7-9 to enable a small cohort of pupils.
- SEN small group tuition for personalised support in literacy and numeracy.
- Running of a Reading Mentor programme.
- Part of funding allocated to Accelerated Reader programme

- Additional Specialist Literacy provision - through the support department
- Use of Software/online resources
- Maths Mastery development
- Numeracy one to one catch up
- Literacy one to one catch up
- Toe by Toe intervention programme

### Evaluation of provision in 2017-18 Record of Year 7 Catch Up Funding Spend by item / project Item

Item / Project	Cost	Objective	Outcome
Resources for reading programme	£4,442	To provide students with weekly reading in the morning and give them access to texts and develop a love of reading.	In English out of the 37 students who did not achieve an average scaled score of 100: 27% achieved a grade 4+ and above 49% achieved a grade 3+
Maths mastery and intervention sessions	£7,698	To consolidate skills in maths and provide support where students are still struggling.	In maths out of the 29 students who did not achieve an average scaled score of 100: 14% achieved a grade 4+ 38% achieved a grade 3+
Small group classes	£12,771*	Teachers provide a nurturing environment and can take a slower pace to deepen learning.	
Additional LSA support	£12,771*	Provide students with one to one support with reading and maths	
Homework clubs	£3,976	To help develop their learning skills and provide teacher support in completing homework.	Helping in supporting our students in completing homework.
