



Dear Parents

I do hope you and your family have enjoyed the break over Christmas despite the restrictions.

The Government's announcement yesterday in light of rising coronavirus cases means that our school will not be reopening for most pupils next week.

For the first two weeks of the Spring Term, we will only be able to offer face-to-face education to vulnerable pupils and the children of critical workers. So, unless your child or children fall into one of these categories, they should NOT return to school as planned next week.

If your child/ren are eligible to attend face-to-face education, and you have filled in the form clarifying this, along with evidence, please bring your child/ren to the front entrance on Wednesday 6th at 8:45am.

For all other children, we will be supporting them through remote learning that will be offered as per a weekly timetable. This timetable will be sent out every week, usually on a Monday morning (although Wednesday morning this week). The timetable will include all of the links for the remote learning to take place and any further information will be communicated through the primary office
